



Notice of Rate Increase

In April 2021, the Board of Commissioners passed a three year rate plan that allows for annual rate increases. **As of February 1, 2023**, the rates for water and service charges (including fire services) will **increase by 5%**. This increase reflects the rising cost of operation and infrastructure maintenance and repair.
